

If awarded how do you intend to use your grant?

This grant will allow us to purchase, install and maintain an Automatic Number Registration Plate Recognition camera. This would collect and record valuable information in both directions of the road which will be used to target drug supply, burglary, theft offences and other acquisition-based crime in and out of ECKINGTON as well as the surrounding areas. A lamp post of choice would provide a suitable lighting, and a safe working environment for the deployment of the proposed ANPR camera.

ANPR cameras will support other tactics in the identification of people/vehicles used in the burglaries and theft offences. It will identify patterns of behaviour and direct enforcements against these subjects. It would also support a range of policing opportunities across the full spectrum of criminality and road safety/casualty reduction. This deployment will complement existing ANPR infrastructure for which we now have National coverage.

The data will be analysed and monitored through police databases, Police resources will then be utilised to act upon the information given by the ANPR camera.
