Fire extinguishers

The fire extinguishers are due for their yearly check. Rosanna is going to book this in as it is done at the same time as the Civic Centre.

<u>Bar Update</u>

- I have emailed Landmarks and asked them to remove anything of theirs from the bar as it has been used for storage
- The bar is to be cleaned on Friday 29th, ready for the renovation and everything will be taken out
- Once the bar is empty and clean, Handymen to paint the walls to freshen it up, take out the old bar pumps and change a few of the cupboards to allow for more space
- I have asked Handymen to make sure that they secure the hatch to avoid accidents
- A padlock will be put on the door to keep any stored alcohol saved
- The bar will be a bottle bar only as it won't have enough use to justify the installation of pumps
- We will purchase the same brands as the Civic Centre to avoid any wastage
- For events who want more alcohol on a pump, than we can ask a mobile bar to come. Marketing Manager is bringing her mobile bar for the Eckington Boy's events.

<u>Wifi</u>

I have asked Handymen if we can move the router out of the bar area as that door will be locked.

If it cannot be moved then we will have to use a padlock with a key to give access to the router in the case of internet issues.

I have asked Handymen to change the wifi password as it is extremely hard to remember

Feedback Forms

After the party on 16th, I wrote out and hand delivered a Thank You card, thanking them for their booking and I enclosed a feedback form, which was completed and emailed the following day with thanks for the personal and thoughtful touch. This is something that I will do going forward.

Google Cards

You can get these as business card sized. All you need to do is scan the QR code and it takes you to the Google Review site where you can leave a review. This is an easy way to get more reviews and showcase the Renishaw & Spinkhill Community Hall as a venue to book.

Wedding Packages

I have considered this and chatted with the Civic Centre Manager about offering a wedding package.

The hall will only allow 100 sitting comfortably – maybe 130-140 maximum capacity.

The kitchen isn't big enough to prepare warm food for a party.

We cannot make it at the Civic Centre and drive it over as we don't have the transport.

Civic Centre Manager and I agreed that moving tables, chairs and decorations from the Civic Centre to the Community Hall may lead to damage.

The best that we can offer is room hire for a reception party, with a cold buffet and a bottle bar. This may appeal to budget weddings as I have been to plenty in the Working Man's Club next door. A buffet arrangement could be made with a local café such as the Renishaw Café or S21.

Party Add Ons

I have thought about speaking with local cafes, such as the Renishaw Café or S21 and seeing if they have fixed price party buffets available for children's and adult's parties.

At the time of booking, we could give the buffet details to save them shopping around.

We could also provide a list of trusted people such as bouncy castles, face-painters, magicians and decoration hire.

This would:

- Save us having to keep requesting insurance details
- Take away a bit of the stress of looking around for recommended services
- Potentially earn us money as we could charge a small fee to add a local business to the list, which we would also put on the Renishaw & Spinkhill Community Hall Facebook page
- Help us to create good community connections with local small businesses
