DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6388 AND ADJACENT ROAD, HIGHLANE) (RESTRICTED ROAD AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that, on the 21st November 2024 the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will come into operation on the 2nd December 2024 and its effect is to introduce;

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

B6388 White Lane in the Parish of Eckington

From a point 235 metres North West of its junction with Phoenix Road to a point 1060 metres North West of the same junction.

The opportunity will be taken to incorporate, into the made order, existing speed restrictions already in place and unaltered by this proposal.

Any permanent Traffic Regulation Orders made prior to this Order, insofar as they relate to the lengths of road listed above, will be revoked.

A copy of the Order and documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection at the County Council's principal offices known as County Hall on Smedley Street in Matlock between 9am and 5pm on each day from Monday to Friday and on request by emailing Place.permanentTRO@derbyshire.gov.uk until 6 weeks after the Order is made until 2nd January 2025.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the ground that a requirement of that Act or any relevant regulation made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the 21st November 2024 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
