
#### **CEMETERY RECORDS**

Our cemetery contains over 10,000 graves and 16,000 interments have taken place in the 146 years the cemetery has been in use.

In recent weeks, Cllr Jeremy Kenyon has been correcting the records and taking a new set of photos of all the books, as well as updating the maps and adding in recent burials.

The records are also now available in additional formats to make it easier to find records. You can access them for free from the Parish Council website.







